

Introduction

Today, low friction has stopped being a promise of the future to become a solid reality in today's Orthodontics, and it is well represented by the Damon System.

results that a few years ago were unthinkable.



The three basic columns in which this treatment stand on are passive self ligating brackets, high tech wires and an specific protocol that allow treatment of complicated cases with the change of only 3 or 4 arch wires in less time than other techniques and with a facial change that is really beautiful, always led by gnathologic principles of functional occlusion.



Besides, the mechanic system allows the simplification of the orthodontic technique avoiding the use of any auxiliary appliances such as expanders, transpalatal wires, distalizers, etc., it also eliminates all the limitations such as the anchorage management and it reduces drastically the need for extractions of permanent teeth and the need of surgery. All this, complemented with functional appliances, leads us to a new perpective, the promotion of the smile and the face driven treatment on top of any other objective. Doctor García Espejo and Dr. Perera are well known Orthodontists that have a vast reputation not only as being excellent teachers but also for their efficiency in the final detailing of their orthodontic cases.

After working very hard training themselves in different Orthodontic techniques, they got together in 2001 in the Damon System and since then they were transformed and now are advocates of this System.

Since they visited Dr. Damon in his clinic in Spokane, Washington, USA in 2003, they have limited their clinic to the Damon System, since they believe it is the best System available in Orthodontics of the 21st. Century.

Dr. García Espejo and Dr. Perera are pioneers in this System, not only in Spain and Europe, but also in America where their experience has been known and they visit to exchange their ideas everywhere.

Dr. Damon himself supports them, since they have a very direct relationship with him, to discuss cases and to improve the system in every way possible.

For this reason, Dr. García Espejo and Dr. Perera have developed a program of Masters in the Damon System in regards to the following specifications:

- 1. A LARGE CLINICAL EVIDENCE: The experience gathered throughout the years has enable them to have a large number of clinical cases treated with the Damon System, they have over 1500 cases that can be followed with all their records and photographs, with all the sequences of treatment.
- 2. STARTING FROM THE BASIS: This will enable the student to evaluate the system step by step of the way without limitations.
- 3. CLINICAL ORIENTATION: There will be workshops and hands-on seminars that will enable the participant to develop the basic techniques, and the follow up of clinical cases directly at the doctors' office.
- 4. TREATMENT PROTOCOL: This will take the participant from the beginning to the end step by step of the way placing a special emphasis on the finishing procedures.

- 2. Posterior cross bite

SAGGITAL PROBLEMS (AP)

3. Class II malocclusion

a. DENTAL: the power of the class II elastics and its differential effect in regards to conventional mechanics.

b. ESQUELETAL: orthodontic and orthopedic treatment combined with the Damon System.

Direct advancement of the mandible with functional appliances (Herbst, Klammt, twin block, bionator, activator, etc.)

Previous tooth alignment (Herbst, Forsus,...)
